Dear parents/carers,

I am delighted to share with you our plans to hold an Art Gallery in school on **Thursday 26th February**, to give our wonderful artists an opportunity to share their skills and artwork with you all. I am going to tie this in with a competition that the Royal Academy of Arts are holding: 'The Young Artists' Summer Show.'

I invite the children to submit a piece of artwork that they're particularly proud of. It may be one they've already created (within or outside of school) or one they're going to produce for the show. They can use any medium of art they choose, from sculpture to painting, mosaic to drawing, printing and even digital art – to name a few. The only requirement is that it's no larger than 950mm wide and 3000mm high. The children need to bring me their artwork on Wednesday 25th February (no earlier please) along with the title of their piece.

There is also an opportunity for me to submit their artwork to the competition run by the Royal Academy, as mentioned above. This is done by sending a photograph of their work, which I will organise. A panel from the academy judges the entries and any winners will have their artwork collected from the school to be displayed online and on-site at the Academy in London.

If your child would like their work to be displayed in the Art Gallery on Thursday 26th February, please give your consent on Microsoft forms [Art Gallery - Fill out form](#) by Monday 23rd February. If they would also like to be entered into the Royal Academy of Arts competition, please complete the permission form below this letter and hand it into me by the same date. I've also attached additional guidance for you to look over for reference when completing the artwork.

Finally, I invite you all to come along to the gallery, which we will be holding from 3.15-4.00pm on the date above. I'm really hoping it will be wonderful opportunity for our artists to shine and allow all children to appreciate the creations of others.
