School Uniform

Dear parents/carers,

As we begin the new school year, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the school's uniform policy and outline our expectations of this within school.

Wearing a school uniform promotes a sense of community, equality, and pride in our school. For us it is a symbol of belonging and something that unites all of the children at St. Leonard's. For these reasons, we ask that the children come to school wearing the correct uniform each day, as outlined in the table below:

Our uniform expectations do not consist of compulsory logos or badges so much of the uniform is available very reasonably at most supermarkets. Should you wish to buy the uniform with our school logo, it is available at SK School Uniform in Tamworth. We ask that children refrain from wearing more expensive, branded joggers and hoodies that have logos on during PE sessions. **We also ask that all uniform is labelled to avoid it getting lost.**

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind you of the expectations of jewellery and hair within school. For safety reasons, in line with our uniform policy, we ask that children who have long hair have it tied back during the school day (if it can be tied back, we ask that it is). Jewellery is limited to a watch and small studs, which we ask to be removed during PE sessions. If it isn't possible for the children to remove their earrings, we ask that they be covered during the PE session (we have protective tape in school should they require it).

Class teachers have shared the uniform expectations with the children and we are really pleased to see the vast majority of our school wearing the correct clothing. We extend our thanks for your support in this matter. If any children do come to school wearing something that isn't school uniform, we'll send a green letter home with them to share this with you.

Pre-loved Uniform Shop

We would also like to remind you that Mrs. Byrne runs a pre-loved uniform shop from the school office. If you would like anything, please send a confidential email to her detailing what you would like (along with sizes) and if she has it, she'll send it home with your child. Contributions for this are 50p per item on ParentPay. Should you have any concerns regarding uniform affordability or availability, please contact the school office and we'll do everything we can to support your family.

We again thank you for your support in this. We want our children to be the very best that they can be and their uniform is the first crucial step in achieving this.
