Following feedback from our parent survey, we are pleased to share the details of our extra-curricular club offer for the Summer Term. We are excited to provide a range of engaging activities that support children's wellbeing, creativity, and physical development. All clubs are open to children of *all abilities*, and we warmly encourage pupils to take part – spaces are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The clubs are now available on ParentPay.

- **Dance – Year 1 & Year 2 (summer 1 only – 6 week club- this will include a video for the website – a permission letter for this will be sent out prior to the club starting)**
Led by Miss Batchelor-Robbins – Tuesdays
- In this lively and creative club, children will work together to choreograph their own dance and help produce a short dance video. This experience encourages imagination, teamwork, coordination, and self-expression. Children will develop confidence as they learn new movements, practise rhythm and timing, and contribute ideas to a final performance they can be proud of.
- **Gardening Club – Year 3 – 6 (Summer 1 and Summer 2)**
Led by Mrs Prentice – Wednesdays
Gardening offers children a calm, hands-on experience with nature. It teaches responsibility, patience and teamwork, while developing an understanding of how plants grow. Gardening is also known to reduce stress and support emotional wellbeing. Children love seeing the results of their hard work as the garden flourishes across the term.
- **Football Club – Year 3 - 6 (Summer 1 and Summer 2)**
Led by Mr Wheatley – Thursdays
Football helps children build physical fitness, stamina, and agility. It strengthens teamwork, communication skills, and sportsmanship. Whether children are new to the game or more experienced, football club provides a supportive and enjoyable environment for everyone.
